
Administrative Officer's Report








North Dakota, One of Four Tugs Stationed In Duluth




The North Dakota is one of the four tugs stationed in Duluth. She is 81' long and powered by a 1250 hp diesel engine. On this trip, she was under the controls of Captain George Latour. Starting Engineer was Clint Ross and Deck Hand Dave Willoughby. Captain George met the enormous Federal Muus just inside the Duluth entry and helped her into Elevator B. It is awesome to watch a little tug move such a big ship with ease. We then went to Fraser Ship Yard to tow another of the Great Lakes Fleet tugs back to their normal spot. Special


